During my seminars and workshops over the past year a frequent discussion topic involved "combination products", i.e., products that contain two or more active ingredients in a single formulation. The number of such products has doubled over the past three or four years, and I suspect the number will increase to some extent in the future. Most contain two active ingredients, but some contain more–Instrata contains three, and one of the newest products introduced to turf markets (Enclave) includes four.

To be sure, fungicide manufacturers have proprietary reasons for combining effective fungicides into a single product. However, there are some real advantages for turf managers. In combination products, more than one "target" inside pathogen cells are disrupted, thereby increasing the potency of the treatment (assuming recommended rates), and broadening the spectrum of activity (the number of diseases "controlled"). Furthermore, the single formulation is optimized to accommodate both (or all three or four) compounds in the product.

Manufacturers recognize that many of our fungicide programs include tank mixes. They created such products to address the market need, and added value along the way.


