Mechanics Corner

Gary Spahr C.G.C.S. at Cedar Chase G. C. had an interesting tip for us about the drive linkage on the Jacobson LF 100's that seem to wear out more frequently than desired. Gary has his crew lube the machine on other points as it's called for in the service manual, but instead of the 30 weight oil that's recommended in the manual they use a small squirt can of the sprayable white lube grease on the drive linkage each time the machine is washed off. Not enough to build up and collect dirt just enough to keep the linkage from binding up. He's had good result's,he has not replaced a drive linkage all season! Amazing what kind of information you can pickup at a superintendent's meeting.
