We had two speakers for the morning session. Brian Anderson of Syngenta lead discussions on chlorothalonil substitutes, cost effective methods of dollar spot control, industry mergers, and snow mold recovery. Greg Lyman, MSU environmental specialist, gave a detailed update on the environmental issues such as changes in fuel storage regulations. progress of the MTESP, and the new buffer strip program just under way. There was a group discussion in the afternoon. Topics included, greens overseeding, divot recovery, ball mark recovery / education, professional relationships between club management, etc.

The Board is hoping to have another round table meeting at the end of the season as a re-cap. Look for a posting later and try to attend.


