# 1991 Turfgrass Field Day will be August 22



The 1991 Turf-grass Field Day, Trade Show and Equipment Auction will be held on August 22nd at the Hancock

Turfgrass Research Center. This year we have instituted a \$10.00 advanced registration charge to cover the cost of lunch, printing the field notebook, postage, and other costs associated with putting on the Field Day. If you don't preregister, you will be charged \$15.00 to register the day of Field Day. Check-in will begin at 8:30 a.m. with the field tour starting at 9:30, trade show at 11:00, lunch at noon and the equipment auction at 2:00 p.m. Again this year, the field tour format will consist of two separate, concurrent tours, one emphasizing lawn care and the other golf course topics. Topics for the lawn care tour will include pre- and postemergence crabgrass control, management of necrotic ringspot disease, fine fescue cultivar evaluations, nitrogen leaching in bluegrass turf, and others. The golf course tour will include putting green speed studies, preemergence annual bluegrass control, creeping bentgrass cultivar

trial, water use rates of fairway grasses, biological control of annual bluegrass, and

The trade show has grown steadily over the past six years and represents the only show of turfgrass equipment in Michigan where you can actually 'kick the tires' and compare the latest in equipment from all the major turf equipment distributors.
